

## SCHOOL ROAD - TRAFFIC & PARKING

## ESSENTIAL INFORMATION IF YOU DROP-OFF OR COLLECT A CHILD BY CAR

As the new school year starts, School and Climbing Bears parents are reminded that there is a voluntary one-way traffic system in School Road, Monday to Friday during term time. The system operates:

8.30 to 9.15 am for morning drop-off 3.00 to 3.45 pm for afternoon pick-up


**ENTER:** School Road by the duck pond from the A272 Billingshurst Road.

**EXIT**: School Road at the junction with Newpound Lane. <u>Please be mindful of this system when parking in Newpound Lane.</u>

WHEN LEAVING THE VILLAGE HALL CAR PARK: <u>DO NOT</u> turn left towards the A272, but continue straight ahead towards Newpound Lane.

## PLEASE REMEMBER THAT YOU CAN ALSO PARK:

In the Three Crowns car park.
In the Cricketers car park.
On Kirdford and Durbans Roads.



Please do not park on the pavement in Newpound Lane opposite the school. This restricts visibility and access, and is a safety concern.

New signage will be put up on a temporary basis to notify and reinforce this one-way system which is a local initiative, agreed by the Parish Council, School, Climbing Bears and School Road residents, to maximise the efficiency of traffic movements during busy times and to improve road safety.

Parents are respectfully reminded that this system is for the safety of your children. It does <u>NOT</u> imply priority for school parking over residents' use of their drives. Please ensure that driveways are kept clear at all times.

Sadly, disrespectful, and indeed occasionally rude, behaviour by a very few parents has caused upset. We therefore request that all parents respect the goodwill shown by residents and avoid unfortunate behaviours that jeopardise the continuity of this system for the benefit of all concerned.
